

Yarn on the Square

Anna's Charity Jumper



Both sizes use 4mm needles and acrylic based yarn. The jumpers are worked in one single piece, beginning with the welt on one side inserting a slit for the neck and adding the cuffs on to finish before sewing up.

Instructions for small size

Cast on 66 stitches

Knit 12 rows rib , change to stocking stitch and continue for a further 46 rows either in one colour, or adding stripes as you wish.

To increase for arms, cast on 27 stitches on either side work a further 24 rows before beginning rib for neck hole.

First neck row : continue with stocking stitch for 39 stitches, begin ribbing across the next 40 stitches, switch back to stocking stitch for remainder of row. Repeat this sequence for a further 7 rows.

Cast off row: Stocking stitch 39 stitches. Cast off the rib stitches.

Stocking stitch to end of row.

Cast on row: Stocking stitch 39 st. Cast on 40 st. Stocking st to end of row. Continue with a mix of Stocking stitch and rib to match the front of neck for 12 rows. Switch back to stocking stitch for 24 rows. Cast off 27 st either side. Continue to work back for further 26 rows. Rib 12 rows. Cast off. Pick up and rib 48 st across each of the sleeve cuffs for 14 rows. Cast off. Sew up sides.

Instructions for larger size

Cast on 78 stitches

Knit 12 rows rib , change to stocking stitch and continue for a further 58 rows either in one colour, or adding stripes as you wish.

To increase for arms, cast on 32 stitches on either side work a further 26 rows before beginning rib for neck hole.

First neck row : stocking stitch for 49 stitches, begin ribbing across the next 40 stitches, switch back to stocking stitch for remainder of row.

Repeat this sequence for a further 12 rows.

Cast off row: Stocking stitch 49 stitches. Cast off the rib stitches. Stocking stitch to end of row.

Cast on row: Stocking stitch 49 st. Cast on 40 st. Stocking st to end of row. Continue with a mix of Stocking stitch and rib to match the front of neck for 12 rows. Continue in stocking stitch for 26 rows. Cast off 32 st either side. Continue to work back for 58 rows to match front. Rib 12 rows. Cast off.

Pick up and rib 62 st across each of the sleeve cuffs for 14 rows. Cast off. Sew up sides.

This pattern gives a basic shape and directions, Should you wish to personalise it by doing twisted rib or textured stitches then please feel free to do so. Should you need any further info then contact us by:
